	Priority 7: Ensure that school-based administrators have the necessary supports to carry out their financial and operational responsibilities in a manner that will allow sufficient time for them to provide educational leadership at their school that will lead to improved student achievement.
	Priority 8: Ensure that the levels of technology infrastructure and technology support at each school are maintained at the highest possible level to enhance the opportunities for improved student achievement.
