Directions

From Halifax to Kentville Fire Hall:

Take Exit 12 off the 101 at the Big Stop, New Minas. Turn right off the ramp. Go straight through 1st set of lights. Turn left toward Kentville at next set of lights. Veer right onto Cornwallis Street (town is one way streets). Take 1st left and proceed through first set of lights. Turn left at Main Street. Fire Hall is on your left, just before the Save Easy store. (463 Main Street.)

From Yarmouth to Kentville Fire Hall:

Take exit 14 off the 101 at Coldbrook. Turn Left at the lights and travel on the #1 to Kentville. (approx: 10 kilometers) Kentville Fire Hall in on your left at 463 Main Street, just before the Save Easy store.

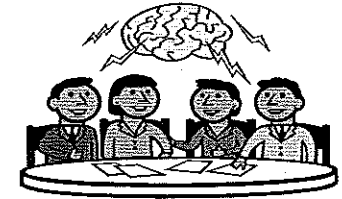

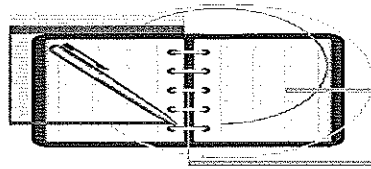

Barry Corbin, M.Ed., is an educational consultant and part-time professor/lecturer in the School of Education, Acadia University, Nova Scotia, Canada. He is currently retired from the Annapolis Valley Regional School Board where he served for over 30 years as teacher, school administrator, curriculum and program consultant and staff developer. Barry has also served as consultant and advisor to several Department of Education initiatives for the province of Nova Scotia, Canada. In his last role with the AVRSB, he served as Youth Pathways and Transitions consultant where he was responsible for researching and developing alternate educational programs and pathways for under-achieving high school students. As an independent consultant, he frequently presents at professional development workshops and in-services on such topics as brain-compatible teaching and learning, multiple intelligences and learning styles, differentiated instruction, authentic assessment as well as collaborative/cooperative teaching strategies. His workshops are enthusiastically endorsed by those in attendance because he engages his audiences with many of the interactive strategies he advocates in his writing.

Barry holds a Bachelor of Science degree (geology) from Acadia University, a Bachelor of Education from the same institution and a Master of Education in Curriculum Development from St. Mary's University in Halifax, Nova Scotia. He is the author of the Corwin text *Unleashing the Potential of the Teenage Brain* (2008) as well as the co-author of two high school social studies texts used in Atlantic Canada. He currently resides in the town of Berwick in the beautiful Annapolis Valley with his wife Ann.
