Section: Operations – Transportation

The Annapolis Valley Regional School Board is responsible for the safe transportation of eligible students to and from the school within the school catchment area in which they reside. The Board will strive to operate an effective and efficient transportation system.

The Annapolis Valley Regional School Board believes that students will walk a reasonable distance to school or to an established school bus stop.

The Annapolis Valley Regional School Board believes that transportation of students who have been granted permission to attend a school outside of the school catchment area established for their residence is the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

The provision of transportation is subject to the requirements of the Nova Scotia *Ministerial Education Act Regulations, Motor Carrier Act, and Motor Vehicle Act.*

Monitoring:

- The Director of Operations is responsible for the implementation, monitoring, and revision of this policy.
- This policy will be monitored annually.
